RE: Updated COVID-19 Policy for PH+T
DATE: June 1, 2023

Effective immediate the following COVID-19 policy and mitigation strategy is in place for Pillsbury House + Theatre until further modified or adjusted. This policy intends to support the ongoing health of our community and is an expression of our values. Should an increase in infection rates, a prevalence/pervasiveness of variant(s), other safety hazards, or new information arise we will revisit and adjust this policy. Space capacity limits are now lifted but may be re-imposed as new information dictates. Masking and testing are the primary tools we have available to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. Thank you for swiftly adopting this policy.

If you are feeling sick or presenting any covid-like symptoms:

1. Please stay home.
2. Test for Covid-19 (tests available at the Front Desk).
 - a. If you are positive, please stay home and quarantine as you're able and let people know who you've been in close contact (15min of time without wearing a mask) with that you've tested positive.
 - b. If you are negative, please monitor your symptoms, wear a mask if at PH+T while feeling symptomatic and re-test if you're still symptomatic in 3 days.
3. Work with your supervisor to determine next steps.

While in the building(s), we strongly encourage wearing a mask though we will not require masks except for specific public events. Please check signs as you enter the building should a mask required event be underway.
